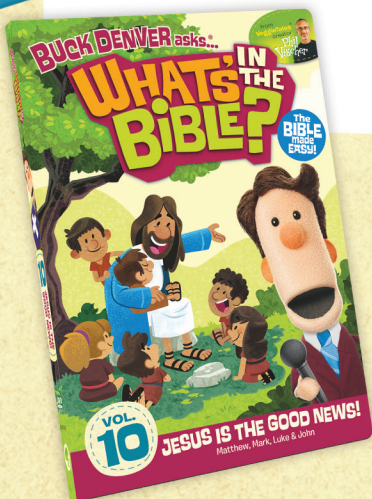


# FAMILY DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. The “fullness of time” reminds us that God’s timing is always perfect. In the 400 years between the Old Testament and the birth of Jesus, God prepared 3 things so that the message of Jesus could spread. Do you remember what they were?
2. Gospel means “good news.” How is Jesus the “good news” and what does that mean for us? Jesus is the fulfillment of all of God’s promises. The Kingdom of God is here and, through Jesus, we can all be sons and daughters of the King! Let’s read Romans 8:37-39 together.
3. When Jesus spent 40 days in the desert, he was tempted by Satan. But Jesus did not give in to temptation because he knew God’s promises. He trusted God. Did you know that when you are tempted by sin - to cheat on a test, or lie to your friend, for example - you can ask God to help you resist that temptation too? Look up 1 Corinthians 10:13. What does it tell us about God’s help?
4. We can learn so much from Jesus’s life! He taught us more about what God is like and He showed us what the Kingdom of God will be like. Do you remember some of the things he taught us about God and His Kingdom? God is loving and powerful. He takes care of His people! When the Kingdom of God is fully here, we will never be hungry or sick or sad - and there will be nothing to fear.
5. God wants us to be a part of His Kingdom - to be sons and daughters of the King. But our sin keeps us away from God, and fills our world with pain and sadness. Do you want to be a part of the Kingdom of God? Do you want to live your life following Jesus? Aren’t you glad that Jesus paid the penalty for all our sin? Let’s talk about how you can join God’s Kingdom!
