

## **Guidelines for Public Services at Rosewood Park Church**

- Personal measures
  - All individuals will be required to wear a mask while in the Rosewood building. We ask that you please bring your own mask. Worship team members and pastors will remove their masks for leading, but will put them back on when finished. If individuals refuse to wear masks or follow the guidelines listed below, they may be asked to leave the building. Masks are available in case you have forgotten to bring one.
  - As you enter the church please use hand sanitizer.
  - Attendees, employees and volunteers are required to stay home if sick or symptomatic, if you have travelled outside of the country in the last 14 days, or if you have been in contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
  - If you are medically vulnerable, it is strongly recommended that you continue to join us for services online instead of in person.
  - All physical contact is to be avoided including hugging and hand shakes.
  
- Parking
  - Please maintain 2 metres of distance between your vehicle and other vehicles. It is preferred if you leave an empty spot between you and the vehicle next to you.
  
- Washrooms
  - Please use the washroom before coming to the church.
  - If needed, washrooms are available for one person at a time. Please leave the sanctuary through the same door you entered through.
  - Please wash hands thoroughly when finished.
  - Once finished please use a provided lysol wipe to go back into the washroom and wipe any surfaces you touched including: toilet and flusher, stall locks and handles, paper towel and toilet paper dispensers, taps and soap dispensers, and door handles.
  - Dispose of lysol wipe in garbage provided outside of the washroom. Do not flush it down the toilet.
  - Please follow marked lanes in the hallways as you go to and from the washrooms. and maintain 6ft of physical distance as much as possible.
  
- Service
  - When you arrive, check in with the greeter so that we can register your attendance. The greeter will direct you to a door to enter the sanctuary.
  - Please bring your personal items with you to your seat including jackets and purses.
  - An usher will then guide you to your seat. Please remain in your assigned seat, whether sitting or standing, for the entirety of the service.
  - Keep your mask on while in the building and while talking to people outside.
  - Offering baskets will be available at the doors to each section.
  - Please maintain 6 feet of distance between yourself and others in your sections that are not from your household. Please exit the sanctuary when your section is dismissed, and exit through the same section door you entered from.
  - Once you are dismissed please exit the church as we are unable to accommodate groups of people congregating in the building.
  - Once outside please maintain 6ft of distance between your household and other households.
